

MISSION TO SEAFARERS FOCUS INTRODUCES OUR WALL OF SAINTS

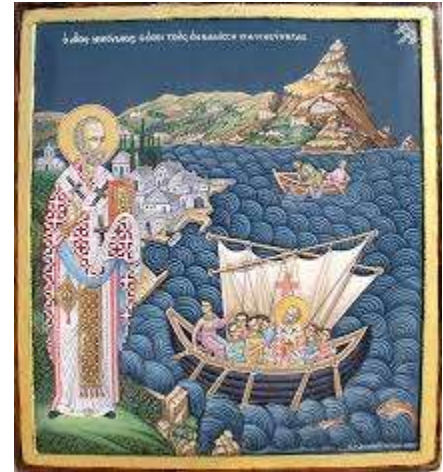

During last week, Father David unveiled the temporary “Wall of Saints” within our church. In the month of October, congregation members are invited to bring small photos or scans of photos of:

- (1) deceased loved ones, especially those who were mentors of the faith,
- (2) former congregation members now deceased, and/or
- (3) particular saints of the church who have a special meaning for them,

and to pin those photographs onto the “Wall”.

The collection will therefore grow over the month and by the first of November, All Saints Day, we will have amassed a collection of, and surrounded ourselves with, all the “saints” of our church family.

Father David started off the wall by pinning an image of St Nicholas, the Patron Saint of Sailors. All Saints’ Marseille has long had a particular focus on Missions to Seafarers and it is most right that our first “saint” on our wall will be the Patron of Sailors. We pray that St Nicholas, of the Father Christmas fame, will be attentive to safeguarding all our Seafarers and in helping us to be vigilant in our ministry towards and with them.

Our “Wall of Saints” will remain in the church until after Remembrance Sunday 8 November 2015.
