It has been a pleasure to welcome visitors and guests to our services over the summer months. I hope those of you who have been away have enjoyed holidays and visiting family in the UK and elsewhere. Our *rentrée* brings a number of events, as we build up to our 175th anniversary celebrations at All Saints' tide.

In particular, we look forward to welcoming two guest preachers to Marseille - on **Sunday**, **13**th **October** The Revd Prebendary Marjorie Brown from England, and on **Sunday**, **3**rd **November (All Saints' Sunday)** our Archdeacon, The Ven Peter Hooper.

Sunday, 14th July

The second Sunday in July marked two events, in addition to being Bastille Day.

We celebrated Sea Sunday at All Saints', when we were delighted to welcome Marc Feuillebois, Manager of the AMAM Seamen's Club in the port of Marseille.
