

How you can help:

If you are a French taxpayer, you can claim tax relief (66%) on your donations.

This enables you to give more to the church by paying the tax relief to us or by giving us more initially.

Your monthly giving	After tax relief this is effectively
20 euros	6.80 euros
30 euros	10.20 euros
50 euros	17 euros
75 euros	25.50 euros
100 euros	34 euros

With a tax refund, why not give three times more?

If you are a **UK taxpayer**, please consider making your donation via a standing order and a Gift Aid form. We can then claim the tax relief on your giving automatically with no action on your part, and HMRC gives us 25% on top of your giving, greatly increasing your donation to us.

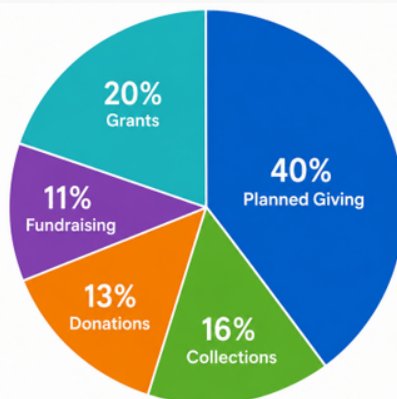

What we need to do now:

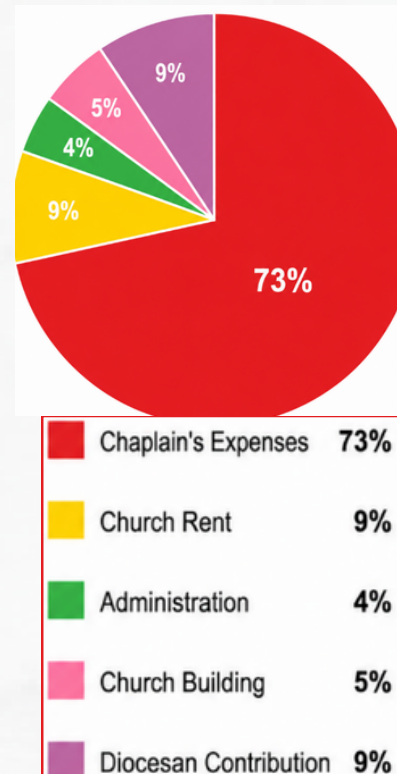
We need to provide the stipend for a part-time chaplain, which will include housing, expenses, health cover etc. in addition to our running costs.

This means we need to raise an additional 1,700 euros a month.

Breaking the figures down...

Whilst immensely grateful to all those who donate at the moment, we need to ask them to do more - and for new donors to come forward - if we are to remain financially healthy and be able to operate in the way we currently do, maintaining church services in four locations, providing pastoral care across the chaplaincy and conducting other essential activities.

We have some reserves we can use, but we need to raise a minimum of an additional 1,700 euros a month which as an example could come from:
